The Canadian Human Trafficking Hotline is a confidential, multilingual service, operating 24/7 to connect victims and survivors with social services, law enforcement, and emergency services, as well as receive tips from the public.

Common signs of forced labour are:

- Forced to work for little or no pay
- Employer is withholding identity documents
- Job is different than what was promised
- Living conditions are substandard or dangerous
- Shows signs of abuse, malnourished, poor personal hygiene
- Fearful, anxious, isolated
- Restricted movement, being controlled
- Forced to repay a debt or an illegal recruitment fee
- Threatened with being fired, deportation or violence
